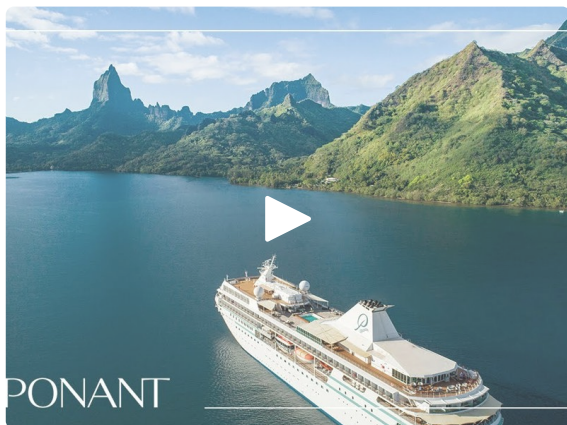


Welcome to Tahiti

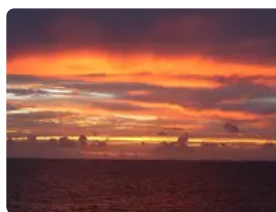
Bora Bora, Society Islands
